Requirements For A Flawless Day

Creative Sounds Entertainment must have access to the reception location at least 2 1/2 hours before the scheduled start time. If the ceremony is taking place at the same location, that start time will be the scheduled start time for the ceremony.

In order to set up properly, Creative Sounds will require a minimum space of 12'x5' (12' parallel to the wall and 5' perpendicular to the wall), preferably near the dance floor and a wall power outlet. When choosing your location for the DJ, it is also best to consider not having dinner tables directly in front of the area. This can cause the music to be very loud for those tables while simultaneously being very low at the back of the room.

Creative Sounds asks that there be at least one power outlet within 50 feet for any outdoor sound equipment set ups.

If there will be any need for sound equipment to be placed outside, Creative Sounds asks that you please provide a canopy (or other covering) to protect the equipment from the elements (rain or sun). If you have any questions about this, please contact us. This may not be necessary for short ceremony needs.

If there will be anyone attending that is prone to seizures, please make us aware ahead of time so that we do not turn on the dance lights.
